ACCESS York is a program dedicated to the elimination of domestic violence. At no cost ACCESS provides a 24 hour hotline, emergency shelter, option and supportive counseling, support groups, a children's program, hospital advocacy, legal advocacy, drug and alcohol support services, a volunteer program, violence prevention programs, outreach, and transitional housing.

Leg Up Farm's mission is to enrich the lives of individuals and families with special needs and unique challenges, through support and customized programs. We believe that everyone is special and deserves the opportunity to reach their full potential. Our individually tailored treatment plans, breadth of services, and engaging environment in a convenient, centralized-location are the keys to success that will improve outcomes for clients and their families.

New Life for Girls is a non-profit rehab located in Dover, PA. New Life for Girls provides a comprehensive residential program for those women who are struggling with life-controlling problems such as drug and alcohol addiction, eating disorders, and sexual abuse issues. In a safe and loving environment lives are changed and transformed.

Sparrow Place is a faith-based nonprofit that was founded when the realization of this gap met with vision and calling. Our primary purpose is to provide women survivors with a safe place to live and the space and resources they need to leave their exploitation behind, FREE OF COST, LONG-TERM, for survivors who are ready to begin their journey of self-care and wellness.

York Benevolent Association provides food supplement of variety and high nutrition. Each household is eligible to receive food once per month. New and used clothing donated by stores, manufacturers, and individuals is distributed at the operations center. Many things other than clothing are also donated — household goods, toilet articles, bedding, furniture and school supplies. For families in financial emergency during the winter months, "The Benevolent" assists in the payment of gas, natural gas, propane, electricity and fuel oil delivery.
