A: HAND QUILTED – Intended for bed use

- A1: Large –300” or more perimeter A2: Small – Less than 300” perimeter

B: HOME STATIONARY MACHINE QUILTED – Intended for bed use

- B1: Large –300” or more perimeter(edge to edge)* B2: Small – Less than 300” perimeter (edge to edge)*

- B3: Large –300” or more perimeter (custom)* B4: Small – Less than 300” perimeter (custom)*

C: MOVABLE MACHINE QUILTED (HAND GUIDED)– Intended for bed use

- C1: Large –300” or more perimeter (edge to edge)* C2: Small – Less than 300” perimeter (edge to edge)*

- C3: Large –300” or more perimeter (custom)* C4: Small – Less than 300” perimeter (custom)*

D: COMPUTER-GUIDED MACHINE QUILTED – (50% or more of the quilt was programmed) Intended for bed use

- D1: Large –300” or more perimeter(edge to edge)* D2: Small – Less than 300” perimeter (edge to edge)*

- D3: Large –300” or more perimeter (custom)* D4: Small – Less than 300” perimeter (custom)*

E: WALL HANGING – Intended for wall décor only

- E1: Large –150” or more perimeter E2: Small – Less than 150” perimeter

F: Miniature: *Must* be a miniaturized version of a full-sized quilt -- 96 inches or less perimeter

- F1: Miniature Quilt

G: Group Quilt: Made by a group of more than 3 people (Block exchange, Round Robin, etc.)

- G1: Group Quilt

H: Miscellaneous: Wearable or any other quilted items (totes, pillows, tree skirts, quilted crafts, etc.)

H1: Miscellaneous I: Youth quilter:

- I1: Youth: Any quilted item made by someone 14 years of age or younger. Age of maker _____

- I2: Youth: Any quilted item made by someone between the ages of 14 and 18. Age of maker _____ **Non-**

judged Categories:

- N1: Display only – any quilted item, may include contemporary or antique items.

- CH1: York Quilters’ Guild Member only – Magazine Challenge 2019

- CH2: York Quilters’ Guild Member only – Grand Entrance Challenge 2020

- CH3: York Quilters’ Guild Member only – 12” Square Challenge 2021
