IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ENTERING QUILTS

1. **Pre-registration is necessary.** Registration forms (which may be downloaded from our website - www.celebrationofquilts.com or completed online) must be received by **Saturday, May 14, 2022**. Printed forms are also available through YQG members. Please contact Cheryl Dawson by email at daws1cheryl@comcast.net or by phone at (717) 846-1225 if you would like to pick up or be sent a registration form. (if necessary leave a message.)

Cost for Quilt Entries: \$6.00 for first judged entry, \$3.00 if quilt is not to be judged and \$3.00 for each additional entry (display or judged).

2. **Registration Forms** must be completed and either submitted online through our website or by mail to Registrar: Cheryl Dawson, 393 Waters Road, York, PA 17403. At the time of registration, please send the completed registration forms and a **non-refundable** fee of \$6.00 for the first judged entry and \$3.00 for each additional judged or ‘display’ entry. You may copy the second page of the registration form to enter more items.

Be sure to **submit a photo of your quilted item online by emailing: celebratequiltsphotos@gmail.com or by mailing to the above Registrar. Include your name, quilt category, title, and size **on the back of photo or in the message of the email** when attaching your digital photo.

3. **The number of entries in each category will not be restricted.** However, judged entries must have been made by the exhibitor(s) and completed in the last 5 years. Entries must not have been judged in previous York Quilters’ Guild Shows. An entry will be critiqued but not considered for an award, if it is entered in the incorrect category.

4. **A 4-inch rod pocket MUST be attached** to the top reverse side of each quilt for hanging. Clothing, miniatures, and other ‘non-hanging’ items do not require sleeves.

5. **All entries must have a cloth label** securely sewn to the back of the quilt with name, address, and phone number clearly printed. As one looks at the back of the quilt, position the label in the lower right corner. Other items need to have a label attached in an insignificant location. Please **cover your name** on the label with tape or fabric.

6. All entries must be clean and free of odor. The Verification Committee reserves the right to refuse to exhibit any entry deemed inappropriate, that cannot be appropriately displayed, or to display only a portion of the quilt.

7. **Quilts should be personally delivered** to York College of Pennsylvania Grumbacher Sport and Fitness Center (enter YCP campus only at 899 South Richland Ave, York, PA 17403) at the WEST entrance between **3:00 PM and 7:00 PM on Tuesday, June 7, 2022.**

8. **Entries must be picked up between 5:30 PM and 7:00 PM on Saturday, June 11, 2022,** by again entering the WEST entrance of Grumbacher Sport and Fitness Center. **Your receipt must be presented** before your entry will be released.

9. First, second, third, and honorable mention ribbons per category will be awarded at the discretion of the judge(s) and their decisions will be final.

10. **Quilts will be accepted for sale.** If you are interested in selling your quilt, indicate it and the price on the registration form. The York Quilters' Guild will retain a 20% commission on each sale.

11. Security will be provided through York College of Pennsylvania. They provide an alarm system and onsite monitoring throughout the week of our show.

12. Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to insure their own quilted items as neither York Quilters Guild nor York College of Pennsylvania may be held liable for any loss, damage, or theft of any entry.

13. The PEOPLE'S CHOICE award will be presented at 4:00 PM on Saturday, June 11, 2022.

Celebration of Quilts 2022 – CATEGORIES

Categories have changed from previous shows. Please read carefully before selecting the appropriate category for your quilt. If your quilt has a mix of quilting, enter it in the category which reflects 50% or more of the type of quilting. JUDGED CATEGORIES:

HAND QUILTED – Intended for bed use

- A1 Large – 300” or more perimeter
- A2 Small – Less than 300” perimeter

Please remove all rods, hangers, or other hangs devices.

HOME STATIONARY* MACHINE QUILTED – Intended for bed use

- B1 Large – 300” or more perimeter - with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- B2 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- B3 Large – 300” or more perimeters- with a custom*** quilted design (a collection of quilting stitches)
- B4 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with a custom*** quilted design (a collection of quilting stitches)

MOVABLE MACHINE QUILTED (HAND GUIDED) - Intended for bed use**

- C1 Large – 300” or more perimeter - with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- C2 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- C3 Large – 300” or more perimeter - with a custom quilted*** design (a collection of quilting stitches)
- C4 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with a custom quilted*** design (a collection of quilting stitches)

COMPUTER-GUIDED MACHINE QUILTED (50% or more of the quilt was programmed) – Intended for bed use

- D1 Large – 300” or more perimeter - with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- D2 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with an edge to edge*** quilting design (all over design)
- D3 Large – 300” or more perimeter - with a custom quilted*** design (a collection of quilting stitches)
- D4 Small – Less than 300” perimeter – with a custom quilted*** design (a collection of quilting stitches)

WALL HANGING – INTENDED FOR WALL DÉCOR ONLY

- E1 Large – 150” or more perimeter
- E2 Small – Less than 150” perimeter

MINIATURE – MUST BE A SMALL VERSION OF A FULLSIZE QUILT - 96 inches or less total perimeter

- F1 Miniature Quilt

GROUP QUILTS – ex. BLOCK EXCHANGE, ROUND ROBINS. (must be made or quilted by a group)

- G1 Group Quilt

MISCELLANEOUS – Wearable or any other quilted items (totes, pillows, tree skirts, quilted crafts, etc.)

- H1 Miscellaneous

YOUTH QUILTER

- I1 Any quilted item made by someone 14 years of age or younger – judged.
- I2 Any quilted item made by someone between the ages of 15 - 18 – judged.

NON-JUDGED CATEGORY:

DISPLAY ONLY –

- N1 Any quilted item - May include contemporary or Antique items.
- CH1 York Quilters Guild Member Only – Magazine Challenge - 2019
- CH2 York Quilters Guild Member Only – Grand Entrance Challenge- 2020
- CH2 York Quilters Guild Member Only – 12”Block Challenge- 2021
(Entry fee will be waived for any challenge quilt not judged.)

Perimeter = Add measurement (in inches) of top + bottom + both sides

*Stationary Machine - any machine that allows the quilter to move the fabric rather than the machine and sits or mounted on a table.

**Movable Quilting Machine - any machine that allows the quilter to move the machine head rather than the fabric and is usually mounted on a frame. (longarm, midarm or quilting frame system for your domestic machine)

*** Edge to edge quilting means a pattern that is repeated from one edge of the quilt to the other. (same pattern overall of the quilt)
Custom quilted is a collection of assorted designs throughout the quilt.
