Dec 5 Holiday Party — Fabric Bingo Quilter's Bingo Rules

- 1. Make your quilter's Bingo Block or Blocks.
- 2. Be sure to bring buttons or pennies to mark your squares.
- 3. Important: Please donate a fat quarter or other small quilting item to be used as prizes.

Playing the Game: The caller will randomly select a card which have the color and type of fabric listed on it. Example, yellow-batik.or blue-flower. If you have the right one you will put a button on that space. Caller will announce what you will need each game for bingo.

GAME CARD INSTRUCTIONS

Materials for 1 (10½") card (Each fabric must be chosen from one of the following categories: batik, floral, geometric, heart, leaf, metallic, holiday, novelty, paisley, plaid, solid, star, stripe, or 1930s print. Use a black print for the center square.)

- 5 (2½") squares assorted yellow and orange prints
- 5 (21/2") squares assorted red prints
- 5 (21/2") squares assorted blue prints
- 5 (21/2") squares assorted green prints
- 4 (2½") squares assorted pink and purple prints
- 1 (21/2") square black print

Block Assembly

 Referring to photos of blocks, join 5 yellow/orange print squares to make 1 row. In the same manner, make 1 red, 1 blue, and 1 green row.

- 2. Join 2 pink/purple squares. Make 2 pink/purple pairs. Join one pink/ purple pair to each side of black square to complete pink/purple row.
- Join rows, placing pink/purple row in center, to complete 1 Bingo Game Card block.
