Based in York, PA, the purpose of the York Quilters' Guild is to instruct, stimulate and promote the art of quilt making on an individual, group and community basis. The Guild meets at 7 pm on the third Thursday of each month at Zion United Methodist Church at 1030 Carlisle Road, York, however some dates, times, and locations have been temporarily modified.

New Stash Builder Activity

If you want to participate in trying to win a bunch of fat quarters just bring one in! You may bring 1, 2, or 3 fat quarters and get the same number of chances to win all of the fat quarters that are brought in. Please bring Quilt Shop quality fabric, either purchased for this activity at a quilt shop or from your stash. But please, be fair to everyone participating and bring in quilting quality all cotton fabrics. You will win all the FQs that are brought in. If we get a huge number of FQs, we will split them in half.

This month's theme for fabric is FALL COLORS or PRINTS. What says FALL to you? Halloween? Thanksgiving? Leaves, Sunflowers? Turkeys? Pumpkins? You choose! You bring in 1, you get 1 chance; bring in 2 or 3, get that number of chances. This is totally voluntary. I hope you'll give it a try.

Treasurer's Report

Following is a summary of activity in the Main Fund during the second quarter—April, May, and June 2021. Receipts totaled \$380, consisting of (1) \$275 from the Half Moon Handwerks fundraising program in May; and (2) \$105 in membership dues and a UFO fee. Expenses totaled \$1,022.37, consisting of (1) \$43.34 administration expense, including the GoDaddy domain name management fee for yorkquiltersguild.com and celebrationofquilts.com; (2) \$181.78 meeting fees and rentals to Zoom and West Manchester Township; (3) \$201.25 membership booklet printing and mailing; (4) \$175 Explore York Membership 2021-22; and (5) \$421 one-year liability insurance premium. The Guild also made the initial deposit of \$373.65 to Bongiorno Conference Center for the April 2022 retreat, which will be reimbursed next year at the time of registration. The July 1 beginning balance is \$3,331.34.

The Show Fund showed no receipts, and the sole expense was reimbursement of the costs incurred to date for the 2022 Raffle Quilt, which were \$446.60. The July 1 beginning balance is \$5,193.39.
