Marge Tucker is an international award-winning quilt artist. The first quilt she made, over twenty-five years ago, was for friends expecting their first child. “At that time, she didn’t know that quilting would become her passion and now her profession. She feel so fortunate to be able to share and continue the tradition of quilting with her students.”

She started with traditional pieced quilts but now focuses on abstract improvisational design in her work.

Marge received “Best Machine Quilting” at QuiltCon 2019 as well as “Best Sewing Machine Workmanship Award – Modern” at the Pacific International Quilt Festival in 2019 as well as numerous other awards for her quilts. Marge received the Best of Show in the Mancuso’s Spring Quilt Festival in April 2021,

Marge teaches throughout the United States and from her studio in Rockland, MA.

Some of our quilting ancestors were ahead of their time! We are not the first generation of quilters to discover improvisational quilting; but we may be the ones who have embraced it and made it mainstream. In this trunk show, she will display antique and vintage quilts that are improvisationally constructed. So much inspiration and some great lessons can be learned from these graphic and abstract “antiques”.
