

ROUND ROBIN

Each person will start out by making a square of your choice to finish at 12 inches. Bring your square and $\frac{1}{2}$ - 1 yard of fabric to pass along that you would like to have included in further rounds. At the February meeting you will pass your block and fabric on to the next person in your group. Each month your block will be passed to another member of your group to work on. Subsequent rounds must have piecing or applique (no plain borders!!!), they can be straight borders or set on point. As you finish a round, please pass on pieces of fabric used to continue on to the next round. Once everyone in the group has added to the piece it will be returned to the maker of the original block, you can then add more or finish as is. Depending on the size of the group will determine when the finished quilt will be shown.

BLOCK SWAP

Each person in your group will make blocks of THEIR choice (ex. 8 participants make 8 blocks) to finish at 12 inches. Hopefully by March you will have 8 blocks ready to swap with the other members of your group. Once you have those blocks you can arrange and piece as you wish, if you want a larger quilt you can make more, add borders etc. After you have swapped you will end up with 8 different blocks to piece and finish as you wish. I hope all will be ready to show their finished pieces at the June meeting.
