

# Regular & Mini Collapsible Cans

Note! Instructions are the same for both.  
Cutting & Supplies are different.

## Supplies

- 4 wonder Clips
- 10" sq of card board (back of tablets)
- 10" sq of scrap batting
- 10" sq of Templar (plastic)

### Mini

- 12" of fabric
- 1 small mouth mason jar lid

### Reg

- 12" x 18" of fabric
- 1 wide mouth mason jar lid

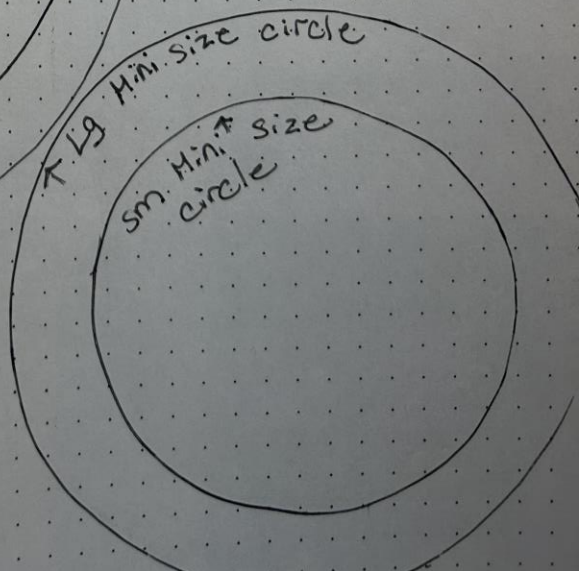
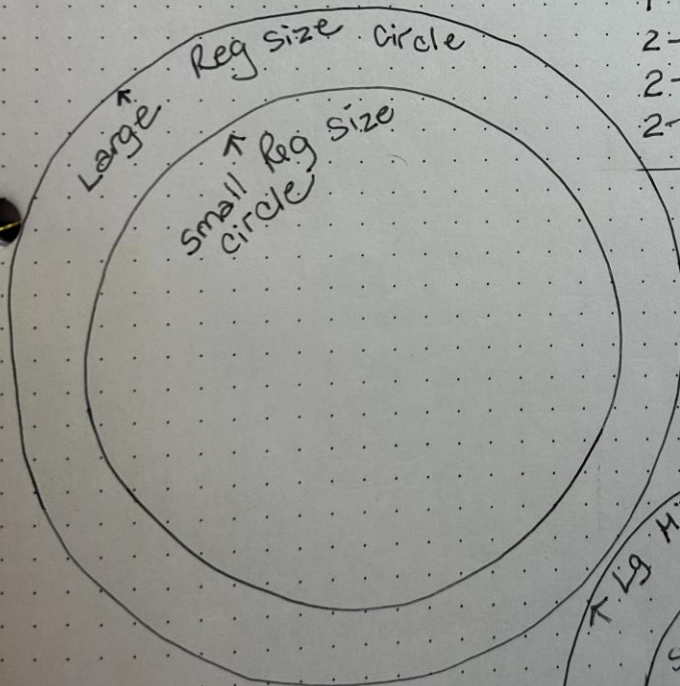
## Cutting

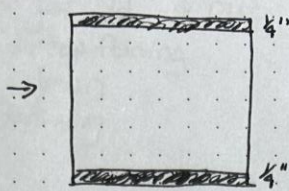
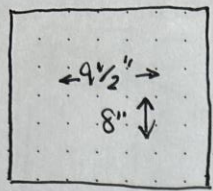
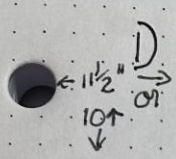
### Mini

- 1- 9 1/2 x 8 rectangle
- 2- 1g mini circles fabric
- 2- sm mini circles batting
- 2- sm mini circles of card board

### Reg

- 1- 11 1/2" x 10 rectangle
- 2- 1g Reg circles fabric
- 2- sm Reg circles of batting
- 2- sm Reg circles of card board





fold  $\frac{1}{4}$ " down & up  
& press to wrong side.

2)



sew w/a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.  
& press carefully not to press flat.  
jus press seam open.

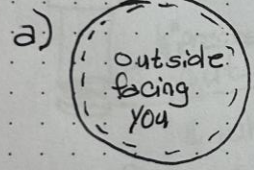


← press open

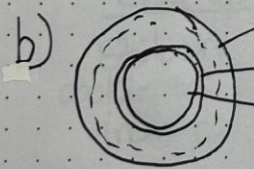
That is the only machine sewing!

3) Cookies



a) take 1 large circle & do a gathering stitch around.



wrongside put  
Batting  
card board



knot

Draw thread & knot

Cookie 1 made

make 2

4) Sew cookies together  
Back to Back



stitch w/a whip stitch or ladder.  
cookie sandwich

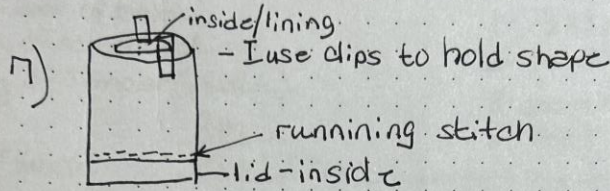
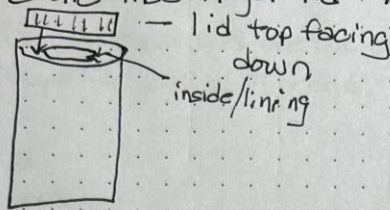
5) With the can fold in half



nice side out

fold

6) Take the mason jar lid & put between or inside



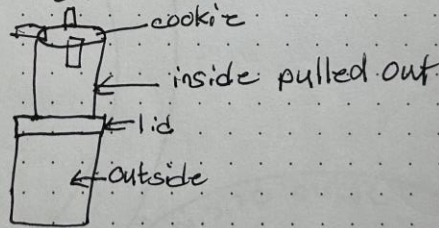
Stitch to hold lid in place

8)  $\frac{1}{4}$ " pressed pull lining through top opening

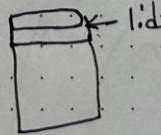


$\frac{1}{4}$ " pressed put your cookie sandwich & whip a stitch

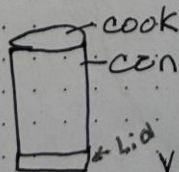
Close up  
Stitch cookie to inside



9) Bend a little to put inside & cookie inside can.



10) Stitch cookie to the bottom of can



stitch around.  
you will have to gether a little cookie is smaller than can
